



PRIZE WINNER'S/AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT RECORD

As a condition of entry, a bowler who has won a total of **\$300** or more in any event, **\$500** in all the available events of any tournament or **\$1000** or more in the last 12-month period – must, **AT TIME OF SUBMITTING ENTRY BLANK**, report their actual score(s), position(s), and amount won. (USBC Rule 319d)

Bowlers are also cautioned to be aware of the average adjustment requirements of USBC rule 319e, which states:

- In a handicap or classified tournament, a bowler shall adjust their entering average if, during the 12 month period immediately preceding the time and date of bowling, the bowler's accumulated average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used for entry by 15 or more pins. In that case, the accumulated average must be used for handicapping or classification purposes.
- The bowler is responsible for keeping a record of the names, dates, scores, and prize winnings in all tournaments entered in the previous 12 months, including those still running. These include all tournament scores bowled in accordance with the game of American Tenpins.
